Avoiding Disgraceful Endings

Psalm 119:33-48 – If you desire to finish strong at the end of your life, it is necessary to apply God's Word now. To avoid a disgraceful ending, diligently learn and relentlessly stay on the scriptural paths.

He

It is easier to <u>observe</u> God's law when we take time to <u>understand</u> it (119:33-34). Putting our <u>eyes</u> on worthless things will <u>lead</u> us to places we don't want to be (119:35-37). Righteous <u>desires</u> will lead us <u>away</u> from disgrace (119:38-40).

Waw

We can only be <u>saved</u> through the <u>love</u> of God (119:41).

The <u>shame</u> and <u>pressure</u> from the world are taken away when we <u>trust</u> in God and His Word (119:42-46). Understanding God's law will lead us from 'have to' to 'get to' (119:47-48).

Application

Urgently cut out any sin in your life that will lead to a disgraceful ending.

Pursue <u>holiness</u> in place of <u>instant</u> gratification.

Trust that He who started a good work in you will bring it to completion (cf. Phil. 1:6).
