Waw

The shame and pressure from the world are taken away when we trust in God and His Word (119:42-46).

Understanding God's law will lead us from 'have to' to 'get to' (119:47-48).

Application

Urgently cut out any sin in your life that will lead to a disgraceful ending.

Pursue holiness in place of instant gratification.

Trust that He who started a good work in you will bring it to completion (cf. Phil. 1:6).
