# **Investigating Biblical Inerrancy**

Psalm 119:81-96 – This culture seeks to lead us astray from God's truth by planting doubt and distrust in our minds. The more we investigate Scripture, the more we find it trustworthy.

### Kaph

Hope in God and His Word gives us unwavering <u>faith</u> in the face of <u>affliction</u> (119:81-87) God has given us all we need to overcome affliction: His <u>love</u> and <u>Word</u> (119:88).

#### Lamedh

God's Word is <u>eternal</u> and <u>unchanging</u> (119:89-91). God's faithful Word is <u>life</u>-giving and keeps us from <u>death</u> (119:92-95). God's Word is <u>perfect</u> and <u>sufficient</u> (119:96).

## **Application**

Prioritize <u>reading</u> God's Word instead of relying on what <u>others</u> say about it. Admit your <u>need</u> for God and <u>trust</u> in His eternal Word. Find <u>joy</u> in <u>reading</u> God's Word.
