## **Befriending Faithful Companions**

Psalm 119:49-64 – The company you keep will dramatically affect how well you follow biblical principles. Beware the wicked and befriend the wise.

# Zayin

The greatest comfort you will find is in the hope of God's Word (119:49-52).

Our relationship with others should be determined by their proximity to God's Word (119:51;53-54).

Our trust in God is shown by our ability to follow God's instruction no matter the circumstances (119:55-56).

#### Heth

We must <u>pursue</u> holiness with <u>purpose</u> (119:57-60).

Intake of God's Word will lead us away from sin (119:61-62).

It is easier to pursue holiness when you are surrounded by others going in the same direction (119:63-64).

## **Application**

Ensure you are the friend pushing others to Christ.

You won't feel like you <u>belong</u> in a church unless you prioritize relationships with the <u>people</u> in it. Your spiritual growth will be <u>stunted</u> if you do not <u>develop</u> deep relationships that prioritize the Word of God.

Our <u>church's</u> growth will be stunted if we do not prioritize consistent <u>groups</u> that focus on growing together in the gospel and going with the gospel.
