Scripture will <u>light</u> the proper path that sin tries to keep <u>dark</u> (119:105-110). No matter your <u>place</u> in life, the Bible contains faithful <u>truth</u> (119:111-112).

Application

Discipleship is a continual <u>process</u> of allowing God's Word to <u>shape</u> you in the image of Jesus. Commit to making <u>progress</u> in the parts of life that matter <u>most</u>. <u>Who</u> is discipling you, and who <u>will</u> you disciple?
